

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING IN ITS ENTIRETY ORDINANCE NO. 72-17, AS AMENDED, WHICH LEVIED OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAXES IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 72-17, which levied occupational licenses in Nassau County was adopted on July 11, 1972; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 72-17 was subsequently amended by Ordinance No. 2006-86, which substituted references to "business tax" for references to "occupational license taxes" in order to reflect changes to Chapter 205, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County, that Ordinance No. 72-17, as amended, be rescinded in its entirety, based on findings and recommendation of the Tax Collector that the further collection of this tax is not cost effective to the citizens of the county.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 28th day of April, 2008, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida that Ordinance No. 72-17, as amended by Ordinance No. 2006-86, is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

This Ordinance is enacted on April 28, 2008 upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of County Commissioners and shall become effective on August 1, 2008.




